Health Service : The school shall provide a regular and free medical check-up of all students with the help of competent doctors. A report of this shall be sent to the parents from time to time. Further, a First AID Room manned by persons qualified in First AID shall be available during working hours.

Library : Books are our best friends... BPS strongly believes in this ideology. Library in BPS is stocked not only with a large number of books on varied topics but also contain multi-media gadgets like DVD's and Cd's. BPS believes in inculcating reading habits from an early stage in the children. Further, news paper reading is a compulsory part of the curriculum.

Laboratories : BPS has two Computer labs equipped with latest networked devices with high-speed internet access and fully licensed software. In addition, BPS also have two spacious and well equipped science labs, one each for Physics, Chemistry & proposes Biology lab. Further, a Mathematics Lab build to CBSE specifications would help children to accept the mathematical concepts in an insightful way.

Music & Dance Studio : This studio is designed to help students learn Indian and Western music on varied instruments along with music theory, history of music and music compositions.

Art Studio : This studio is the home of drawing, painting and other handicrafts both traditional and modern as well as Indian and Western.

Eligibility for children under RTE category (Nursery)

- (a) 25% of the total seat reserved under RTE category are for children belonging to:
- (i) Weaker Section (ii) Disadvantaged Group
- (b) Admission will be granted on the basis of Draws
The child should have been born between 1st October, 2015 and 30th March, 2016 (age between 3 and 3 ½ years inclusive of both the dates).
- (d) After the declaration of admission the parents/ guardians will be issued an admission form, which is to be submitted for final admission (along with the required document and two passport size photographs of the student) in the school office before last date, failing which the seat will be treated as vacant and may be filled in by the next eligible candidate.
- (e) Admission of a child to the school will mean complete acceptance by the Parents/Guardians of all school rules as in force or as amended from time to time. Rules are subject to change at the discretion of the principal.
- (f) Name and date of birth as recorded in the Nagar Nigam Certificate will be considered final.
- (g) Following documents are to be submitted along with duly filled in Registration form:
- (i) Copy of Birth Certificate issued by the Nagar Nigam.
- (ii) Copy of SC/ST/OBC certificate if applicable
- (iii) Copy of medical certificate, from Chief Medical Officer, of person with disability, if applicable.
- (iv) Applicant must submit his/her own income declaration certificate in the prescribed performa.

(Annexure I)

- (a) The above declaration (Annexure I) must be duly certified (Annexure I) by two responsible persons (Member of Parliament / Member of legislative Assembly/ District Head/Pardhan/Member of Zila Tehsildar/ Parishad/ Sarpanch/ Ward Panch/Mayor/Member of Municipal Corporation / President of Nagar Palika/ Member of Nagar Palika/Gazetted Officer/ Government Officer).
- (b) Own income declaration (Annexure I) with certification of two responsible persons (Annexure I) will be attested by Judicial Magistrate/ Tehsildar (Annexure K).
- (i) If the applicant is filling Income Tax return, then attested of acknowledgment of Income Tax return and PAN card must be submitted.
- (ii) BPL Card holder must submit the attested copy of BPL Card as an income proof.

There will be no admission test for selection of students.

The Parents/ Guardians are requested to go through the detail inside this Information Brochure carefully. It is advised that the Registration/ Admission form be filled in, if they agreed to abide by all the terms and conditions mentioned.

The information on rules and regulation given herein cancels any contained in any previous document. Further the management reserves the right to change them as and when deemed necessary.

A lottery will be held for selecting students for admission and results will be declared on the same day, strictly as per rules and regulations of the Govt/ of Rajasthan. The date for lottery shall be intimated to the parents at the time of registration.

Any influence or pressure on the Principal to get the student admitted will be viewed seriously and will entail cancellation of the Registration.

Note: Registration Fee is exempted for children under RTE Category.
